



Academic and Career Planning (ACP) *Implementation Plan*

At OHS, our students engage in an extensive ACP process that includes personal awareness, career/educational awareness, career-based decision making, and experiential reflection. Throughout their high school experience, students participate in a wide range of ACP activities through a variety of methods. Beginning in 9th grade, our students participate in weekly adviser led ACP lessons that provide the personal and educational exploration required to confidently identify a specific career cluster by the end of their freshman year. This cluster choice focuses the students' 10th – 12th grade ACP experiences, helping them refine a specific, relevant educational and career choice. As a result, students are able to confidently make appropriate educational/career choices as they enter their senior year.
