School Information

Ozaukee High School is a comprehensive public high school serving grades nine through twelve. The school provides a wide academic range of coursework that includes Advanced Placement, dual-credit, college-prep, technical, fine arts, and extended support in math, science, and language arts. Beyond the classroom, we offer 12 varsity sports and 20 clubs.

Our student population comes from five rural communities within the northern region of Ozaukee County. Our student demographics include 87% White, 1% American Indian or Alaskan Native, 1% Asian, 2% Black or African-American, 8% Hispanic/Latino with a 31% economically disadvantaged rate. From our Class of 2021, 44% attended a two or four year university, 27% enrolled in a technical college, 2% joined the military, and 27% entered the workforce.

The mission of Ozaukee High School is to foster a culture of learning that builds an academic, personal, social and career foundation for each student. Our staff, students, parents, and community are committed to the development of academic excellence, intrinsic motivation, personal and social responsibility, and sensitivity to diversity.

Schedule

Ozaukee High School is on an A/B block schedule where students are enrolled in eight 85-minute classes each semester. Courses meet on alternating days. There are two semesters per academic year.

Students earn a half-credit for each class hour per semester. A full student schedule equals eight credits per year.
