Consent Agendas: Motion to approve Consent Agenda Part I was made by S. Burmesch, seconded by J. Decker.

Motion carried unanimously.

Consent Agenda Part II - We have one staff member we are bringing forward as a resignation: Daniel McDonnell (OMS/OHS Choir Teacher). We also have three staff members that we are bringing forward as hires for approval:

- Linda Weyker
 OHS Special Education Teacher (Salary \$66,000 Full Time Teacher plus benefits)
- Travis Kornely OMS/OHS Career and Technical Education Teacher (Salary-\$73,000 Full Time Teacher plus benefits)
- Kristy Skowronski OHS Special Education Paraprofessional (Approximately 27 hrs/wk at \$16.50/hr Part Time Paraprofessional plus part time benefits)

Motion to approve the resignation of Daniel McDonnell and the hiring of the three staff members as outlined above, was made by D. Large, seconded by S. Burmesch. *Motion carried unanimously*.

Monthly Reports:

Board chairpersons in attendance provided an update on recent committee meeting activities.

Finance/Buildings & Grounds: Work on the roof is moving forward. We are waiting on DNR approval for the drainage pipe. Once that is approved, we are able to move forward on the culvert. At the August 10th meeting, the committee will be discussing the plan for the playground. Ford is no longer making 10 person transit vans. The order that was placed in November 2021 has been canceled. Now we need to begin the research process over again.

Student Learning & Achievement: The committee met to discuss student academic standards. The committee will be working on a survey that will go out to recent graduates to gauge how we (as a District) did in helping students succeed.

Information/Action Items:

Student Academic Standards: D. Karrels explained how students in our District will receive instruction and be assessed on standards that are a combination of locally developed, state adopted, nationally adopted and those relating to the ACT College and Career Readiness Standards. Our goal is to have better alignment of standards across all three schools.

S. Burmesch made a motion, pursuant to section 120.12(13)(b) of the state statutes to approve the 2022-2023 student academic standards with a date of July 18, 2022, and with said academic standards constituting the Board-adopted standards that are required under section 118.30 (1g)(a) of the state statutes. He also motioned to direct and authorize the administration to take any necessary actions to incorporate the Board-2022-2023 student academic standards and to issue a notice for parents/guardians that is consistent with the requirements of section 120.12 (13) of the state statutes, seconded by J. Clark. *Motion carried unanimously*.

Vape Sensors Approval: The District is looking to purchase 12 vape sensors to install within various locations of the high school and middle school. The use of the sensor system would allow administration to have better working knowledge of locations and times of possible usage of these illegal devices in our school. K. Klas made a motion to purchase 12 Verkada Sensors at a total cost of \$19,512, based on an analysis of devices and feedback from checked references, seconded by S. Burmesch. Motion carried unanimously.
