

## SCHOOL BOARD NOTICE OF INTENT TO FILL SCHOOL BOARD TOWN OF BELGIUM SEAT JULY 8, 2025

The Northern Ozaukee School District Board of Education - Town of Belgium Seat was vacated on June 24, 2025. The School Board is undertaking a process to make an appointment of a qualified elector to fill the Town of Belgium vacancy. The appointee will hold office from the date of the School Board appointment (August 11, 2025) until the spring election in April 2026.

**Eligibility:** To be eligible for this seat, you must be a citizen of the United States and live in the Town of Belgium within the Northern Ozaukee School District boundaries at the time you take the oath of office.
