Athletic Director Report: Andy McKee, NOSD Athletic Director shared a presentation highlighting the

accomplishments of our student athletes from spring sports until now.

**Seclusion and Restraint Report:** There were zero instances of a student involved in restraint and zero instances of a student involved in seclusion during the 2024-2025 school year. Motion to approve the

report as outlined was made by D. Large, seconded by J. Schubert. *Motion carried unanimously*.

**Neola Policy Updates (2<sup>nd</sup> Reading):** A variety of Neola policies were presented for second readings. The list of policies are on page 23 of the board packet. Motion to accept the second reading of the Neola

policies was made by H. Steffen, seconded by S. Burmesch. Motion carried unanimously.

**OPEB Investment:** The District has an employee benefit trust fund to help cover future retiree benefits. When an employee retires, specific employees (based on years of service) are eligible for different allocations of money to be used for medical insurance premiums and medical expenses. No contributions have been made to the trust since 2022-2023, due to the liability being close to fully funded and the goal is to not overfund the trust.
